CAP

“CAP exist because nobody should be held hostage by debt and poverty. But the truth is that they are rife in the UK. In a society where people live behind closed doors, thousands are desperately poor. Unable to feed their children, incapable of paying to heat their homes in winter, the grip of poverty is relentless. It breaks families apart and drives many to think that suicide is the only solution.

We are passionate about releasing people in our nation from a life sentence of debt, poverty and their causes. Through our services, which are all run through local churches, we are tackling poverty head on. Our vision is to bring freedom and good news to people in every community through 1,000 CAP projects by 2021.” As part of our pastoral care programme in the benefice, Tim Jackson has trained as a CAP Money Coach. You will have the opportunity to learn more about CAP in the coming months. CAP Money not only assists people that are already struggling with poverty but also helps young people develop good habits to avoid poverty and helps people at transition points in their lives. This is complimentary to the Theology and Mission course he is studying at St Augustine’s College (formerly SEITE) and will involving him volunteering with CAP for 60 hours.

As part of his time with CAP, Tim will be hosting a supper on **Friday 22nd September** where there will be an opportunity to discover more about CAP and a speaker from CAP will make a presentation. There will be a voluntary collection for CAP and an opportunity to support its valuable work going forward. More details about the supper will be given nearer the time but please **save the date**.
